

Member Volunteer Introduction for Membership P&P

MEMBERSHIP

A person who, on the day the association is incorporated, was a member of the unincorporated association and who, on or before a day fixed by the management committee, agrees in writing to become a member of the incorporated association, must be admitted by the management committee to the same class of membership of the association as the member held in the unincorporated association.

A member of the incorporated association who before becoming a member, has paid the member's annual subscription for membership of the unincorporated association on or before a day fixed by the management committee, is not liable to pay a further amount of annual subscription for the period before the day fixed by the management committee as the day on which the next annual subscription is payable.

An applicant for membership of the association, other than the members of the unincorporated association mentioned in subsection 1 must be proposed by 1 member of the association (the proposer) and seconded by another member (the seconder)

An application for membership must be in writing; and signed by the applicant and the applicant's proposer and seconder; and in the form decided by the management committee

MEMBERSHIP FEES

The Membership fee for each class of membership is the amount decided by the members from time to time at a general meeting and is payable when and in the way the management committee decides

ADMISSION AND REJECTION OF MEMBERS

The management committee must consider an application for membership at the next meeting of the committee held after it receives the application; and the appropriate membership fee for the application. The management committee must decide at the meeting whether to accept or reject the application. If a majority of the management committee members present at the meeting vote to accept the applicant as a member, the applicant must be accepted as a member to the class of membership applied for. The secretary of the association must, as soon as practicable after the management committee decides to accept or reject an application, give the applicant a written notice of the decision.

ADMISSION PROCESS

A new Member/Volunteer shall be introduced/given a Member Volunteer Introduction Pack on their enrolment for membership to SSC. This pack includes the following;

It will be given in two parts,

Part one, to initially enroll the member (Membership Enrolment Form Blue Card Application Form& and Part two after the committee has accepted the application.

As a new member/volunteer they will be required to pay the fee of \$5.00 to become a member (that fee must be paid annually or the membership will become void)and once a member they will be covered by SSC Insurance when they do volunteer under the rules of the SSC Constitution. They will also receive a complimentary identification badge and a sun smart shirt.
