

# *Sailability Sunshine Coast Queensland (SSCQ)*

## *Service Recognition and Membership Categories P&P 2020*

This Policy and Procedure document is to define processes and definitions for Service Recognition and Membership categories for Sailability Sunshine Coast Queensland (SSCQ) and stands as a By-Law under the Constitution, expanding the information there-in.

### **Service Recognition**

There are two stages recognising length of service as a volunteer at SSCQ. This recognition will usually be presented at the SSCQ AGM.

#### **Ten Years of service:**

After 10 years of active service the volunteers will be presented with a silver badge stating “10 Years”.

#### **Life Members**

After 15 years of active service the volunteer will be made a Life Member, or at the discretion of the Management Committee to recognise special service, and be presented with a gold badge stating “Life Member”.

### **Membership Categories**

<b>Membership Category</b>	<b>Definition</b>	<b>Voting Rights At General Meeting</b>
Ordinary Member	A person who is over 18 years of age and volunteering for the association	Yes
Active Life Members	A person who has been accepted at an AGM after 15 years of volunteer service, or at the discretion of the Management Committee to recognise special service, and who has volunteered or attended a general meeting in the past two years.	Yes
Non Active Life Members	A person who has been accepted at an AGM after 15 years of volunteer service, or at the discretion of the Management Committee to recognise special service, and who has not volunteered or attended a general meeting in the past two years.	No
Honorary Member	Person or organisation invited to membership by the management committee in the interest of the association for such a period as may be deemed appropriate.  Persons or organisations donating to SSCQ will be deemed to be an Honorary Member for 12 months from the date of the donation.	No
